

MURA-character

- (1) & (2) are found in signatures dated 1501
- (3) & (4) are found on blades dated 1504-1521
- (3) & (5) are found on blades dated 1573-1592

Character (3) is found in all periods and you should be careful, almost all of the fakes have this character.

The tanto of Mr. Tsuruta seems to me the 5th version (I've made a layered picture, see below)

Character Mura variations 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5








